

National Funeral Directors and Morticians Association, Inc.

2017 Scholarship Program

The National Funeral Directors and Morticians Association, Inc. has established a scholarship fund to provide scholarship awards to full-time students enrolled in accredited colleges of mortuary science. Scholarship amounts will be determined annually by the organization. The number of awards may vary each year. The selection of recipients is competitive and recipients must meet the established criteria. All awards are paid directly to the mortuary school to be applied toward tuition. **Applications must be received by the committee by June 30, 2017. Applicants submitting late or incomplete applications will be eliminated from the competition.**

CRITERIA

To be eligible for an award, a student must:

1. Have completed at least one of the last three quarters as a full-time student in a program of Mortuary Science education or funeral service accredited by the American Board of Funeral Service Education.
2. Have demonstrated responsibility with a good attendance record and minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Have demonstrated qualities of professionalism which are needed for success in funeral service.
4. Be a citizen of the United States.

PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS

Students who are enrolled in one of the last three quarters of mortuary school may apply. The applicant must:

1. **Submit**
 - a. **Official college transcripts** of all college credits with the college seal
 - b. **Two letters** of recommendation from
 - 1) An active **member** of the NFD&MA (Not a committee member)
 - 2) An **instructor** of the mortuary school where the student is enrolled or a **mortuary employer or supervisor** where the student is or has been employed. (Not a committee member)
 - c. A **one-page typed essay** which expresses interest in funeral service, including background information that may indicate future success in funeral service.
 - d. A recent **photo**
 - e. A completed **application form**.
2. **Return the application package by June 30, 2017** to The National Funeral Directors and Morticians Association, Inc., Education Commission, 6290 Shannon Parkway, Union City, Georgia 30291.
3. Be **interviewed** by the Scholarship Committee.
